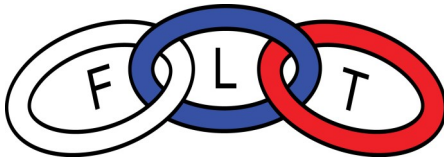

This Memorial Day let us take time to remember those who have been taken from us.

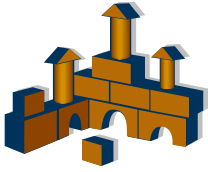
As we mourn their loss let us reflect on Psalm 23:

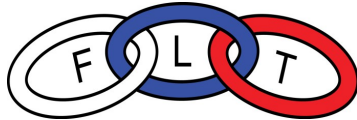
